



# Home Learning Expectations and Expectations for Students Who Arrive After Term 1

Students at Waitakere Primary School complete home learning challenges throughout the year at home.

Students are expected to complete a set number of personal choice compulsory challenges and all the academic compulsory challenges by the close off date, which is set at the beginning of the year and is stated on the home learning challenge sheets.

Evidence of completing challenges must be presented to their class and teacher **before** the close off date for it to be considered as completed. **A maximum of two challenges can be presented to the class each a week. No late completions will be accepted.**

The number of personal choice compulsory challenges students must complete is dependent on what year level the student is in. Students who arrive after Term 1 are expected to complete the compulsory academic challenges and a reduced number of personal choice challenges, depending on what term they arrive at the school.

A copy of the home learning challenge sheet should be given to all new students that arrive during the year, along with expectations of the number of challenges to be completed by the close off date.

Only students who have satisfactorily completed and presented the required number challenges (academic and personal choice) will be entitled to attend the end of year celebration events.
